A NEW Year in this business usually brings new demands for gaming harmonisation in Europe – but I'm sure anyone who understands the inner mechanics of the gaming business will agree that hell will freeze over first! There are three main reasons for this: 1) gaming legislators; 2) gaming regulators and 3) the gaming industry itself – all in all a pretty potent mix. Legislators will always be swayed by public opinion because they know that relaxing gaming laws does not win votes. It does not matter that the jurisdiction over the next European border may adopt a freer approach to gambling. Regulators are of a slightly different breed. While they advise governments on the merits and pitfalls of gaming, their main interest is in keeping a tight grip on the industry – but this often results in a restraint on business creativity.

Fortunately outside these generalisations there are those legislators and regulators who are prepared to adopt a more pioneering, progressive approach to gaming; people who have the vision to see the industry as a welcome contributor to the leisure sector and the national economy. But as 2003 approaches and the perennial demands begin for gaming harmonisation let me add that the final block on this will come from the industry itself. Harmonisation necessarily means co-operation – give and take – and this is only ever attractive to those regimes with nothing to lose. No industry which is reasonably happy with its gaming laws will be prepared to lose concessions they have fought long and hard for, in order to harmonise with those less successful.

As we ring in 2003 it is co-operation rather than harmonisation that is needed. And it is countries such as France (the big one!) which needs help to prise its coin-op doors open and it is regulators such as those in the UK who could use their expertise to help this to happen.

I hope that 2003 will be a year of co-operation and unity between nations at all levels both in business and – more importantly – in humanitarian terms.
